The candidate of 2000 to 2005 Admission should submit their application for First Semester, Third Semester and Fifth Semester in their respective college and Second Semester, Fourth Semester and Sixth Semester in the University. The candidate of 2006 to 2019 Admission should submit their application for First Semester, Second Semester, Third Semester, Fourth Semester, Fifth Semester and Sixth Semester in the University

Date of Commencement of Examination will be announced later. The Examination fee details are available in the University Web site. Detailed Time Table will be published in the Information Centres, Examination Centres and in the University Web site.



Candidates registering for the mercy chance examination should remit Mercy chance fee <u>in</u> <u>addition to the normal Examination fee.</u>

The Mercy Chance fee:

- 1. If the number of papers is three or less
  - a. If Scheme/Syllabus has elapsed (2011 Admn to 2019 Admn) : Rs.7,500/-
  - b. If Scheme has elapsed more than 10 years prior to the existing scheme (2000 Admn to 2010 Admn) : Rs.10,000/-
- 2. If the number of papers is more than three : Rs.2,500/- per paper

5% of increase in the fee/charges should also be remitted by the candidates registering for the examination as per U.O. No. Ad.A5.03/9871/2019 dated 01.04.2019.
